Wonderpets All Animal Training uses a scientific and holistic approach to animal training, exclusively using of positive reinforcement to create and increase desired behaviours. Expect to use a large amount of treats during classes, so do not feed your dog a meal before class. I recommend very high value treats as well as a lower value treats. Treats should be cut small, approximately the size of a small kibble. To determine the value of a treat, place several different treats on the ground in front of your dog and notice which ones get eaten first. Some examples of high value treats for my fussy dog things like are cooked chicken, glutenfree hotdogs, cheese, sausages etc. Lower value treats to her are commercially available treats.

All dogs must be on leads at all time with either a harness or flat collar.

All dogs must be up to date with vaccinations.
